I am also grateful for Scott Abel (our Lay Leader) who will also assist in preaching in the Life on the Road Service.

I will continue to preach at every 8:30am service but will occasionally move between the 11am traditional and LOR service. The five of us are currently finalizing a preaching schedule through April 2019. I am fully confident in God's ability to work through us and to lead this church into a vibrant and faithful future. As the prophet Isaiah so boldly proclaimed: "Do not fear, for I am with you, do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will help you. I will uphold you with my victorious right hand!" (41:10)

The Pastor Parish Relations Committee will work closely with the Bishop on our next appointment. Although it is possible to receive a new appointment at any time, it is likely we will not receive a new appointment until next summer.
